# Airfare

You may fly from either Sarasota International Airport or Tampa International Airport. All flights should fly into Denver, Colorado, which is approximately 35 miles from Boulder. It is recommended that climbers secure transportation from the airport to Boulder prior to arriving in Denver. There will be a half day training session with the Colorado Mountain School on Friday afternoon so it is recommended that you fly into Denver on Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

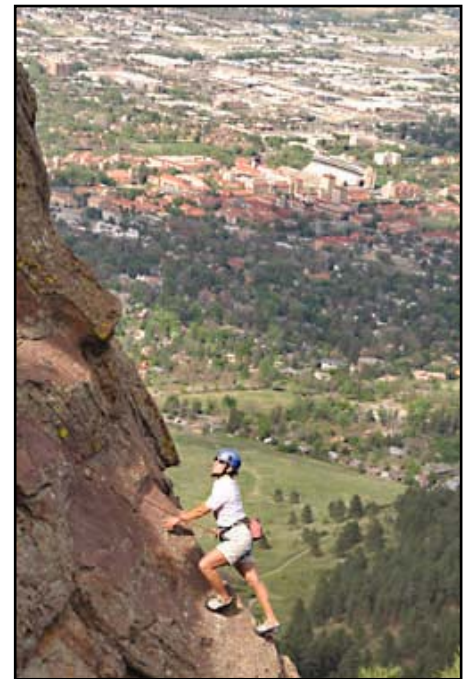
# Climb Information

The Colorado Mountain School has offered a special climbing package for this United Way fundraising event. Each Climber will participate in a 3-4 hour preparation session on Friday, September 24<sup>th</sup> followed by the official climb on Saturday, September 25<sup>th</sup>. The climb will take place on the First Flatiron of Boulder, Colorado. This climb is expected to take approximately 6-8 hours and will reach 1000 feet. For those climbers that would prefer something more entry level, there are more than 40 established routes in the beginner to intermediate range as well as guided hikes through the Rocky Mountains.

The cost for the 2 day session is estimated to be between \$260. These prices include both the preparation and climb sessions, and all necessary technical equipment. Each participant would need to provide their own personal gear (clothing, backpack, rain jacket) as well as food and water. A full list of equipment for the climb is included in this packet.

## About the Flat Irons

The immense First and Third Flatirons rise over Boulder like unmistakable landmarks signaling the presence of the Rockies.
